Excerpt from Journal of Social Science, 1878, Vol. 9 The Journal of Social Science has been irregular in its publication ever since it began in 1869; but in the nine years, nine successive numbers have appeared, besides three Extra Numbers, containing the Proceedings of the three Conferences of Charities, - at Detroit in May, 1875, and at Saratoga in September, 1876, and September, 1877. Hereafter it is the hope of the Editor to publish it regularly, and more frequently. This depends mainly upon the income of the Association from membership fees and other sources, from which the expenses of publication are paid. In consequence of the financial depression in the country since 1874, this income has been too small to admit of frequent publication. To meet that and other necessary expenses, it has been necessary to rely upon sources which may be called extraordinary, and which may fail us at any time. The Association has no funded property; its regular income is composed chiefly of annual payments from members, which now amount to less than \$1,800 per...
