

The distention of the coil is greater, the abdomen is more tympanitic, sensitiveness at the seat of obstruction is now manifest, and the increased resistance of the occluded coil may be felt. If the coil be small, the increased resistance of the intestine on the proximal side of the occlusion may le felt and a circumscribed dullness may be outlined. This varies with position, depending upon the portion of the intestine involved in the strangulation, as shown in the von ZoegeManteuffel plates. Peristalsis is very greatly increased and is most pronounced in the neighborhood of the obstruction. The increase in peristalsis continues until peritonitis sets in, when it entirely disappears.
